Dear organizer,

The group and its team travel the roads all year round, thank you in advance for welcoming them in the best conditions to guarantee the quality of the show (even if certain aspects of the technical sheet may seem picky, know that they are necessary to the well-being of artists and technicians).

In most cases, we avoid doing sound-check. We prefer doing line-check shortly before the concert.

Please provide a parking space as close as possible to the stage for a 9-seater van (2.8m high). This vehicle will be under permanent surveillance and under the responsibility of the organizer. Make sure that the vehicle loading area as well as the entire material transit area is clear and well lighted. Please provide 2 experienced people for unloading and reloading the truck, available as soon as the group arrives.

Technicians employed by Ulysse Prod do not work at height. Adjustments requiring work at height must be carried out by a technician duly trained and authorized for this task.

As soon as the group arrives, we will need a stage manager who perfectly knows the venue where the concert is taking place, 1 sound technician and 1 light technician who are perfectly familiar with their installations. They must be present during all the sound-check and the concert, so that any problems encountered can be quickly resolved. In the event of an open-air concert, the stage, sound wings, control rooms and all equipment must be perfectly protected from bad weather and the sun.

The backline space reserved for the SIDI WACHO stage manager must be on the side of the stage and must not be accessible to unauthorized people during SIDI WACHO set changes.

If you encounter any difficulties regarding our needs, please contact the manager as soon as possible. We remain open to all proposals, as long as they are widely anticipated. Thank you for your understanding.


#OUR NEEDS

- 2 Shure wireless microphones UR4D, ULX, GLX-D, BLX-D or better (we need to be able to adjust transmitter gain) with SM58 head
- 2 identical 800W bi-amplified wedges and identically amplified in 8 ohms with a 15 ", on stand, in sides.
 If the stage is large, a larger system is welcome with 2 sub.
- Microphones and microphone stands as requested below.
- 2m X 2m samia-type platforms on casters, 40cm from the ground, for percussions
- 16 x LR6 batteries such as Duracell +
- 1 RJ 45 cat 5 from FOH to stage, preferably on stage right, to connect our stagebox

We usually travel with our own backline and mixing desk (a Behringer Wing). However, in the event we travel by plane, please provide a Wing, or a Yamaha QL or CL desk, and the following backline:

- 1 Conga + 1 Tumba with stand > LP Classic, patato ...
- 2 Timbales (14" and 15") with a stand and a bell stand > LP Tito Puente or Prestige
- 1 Snare (13") with a tall stand > DW, Yamaha, Gretsch, Ludwig ...
- 2 Toms (10" and 14") on clamp > DW, Yamaha, Gretsch, Ludwig ...
- 1 Kickdrum (18") with pedal > DW, Yamaha, Gretsch, Ludwig ...
- 3 Cymbal stands (1 of 3 with boom)





WELCOME RIDER

DRESSING ROOM

A room of sufficient size to accommodate 8 people. The room will be heated according to the season. It will be provided:

- a large table, enough chairs and armchairs for the team.
- a sink with soap and a toilet will be in or near the dressing room.
- The room will also have a fridge, sockets (16A), a clothes rack with hangers, a trash can, glasses or mugs, paper towels, cutlery in sufficient quantity.
- One ironing board and one iron.

The key to the room will be given to the band on arrival, who will return it on departure.

IMPORTANT:

If the room does not lock, the organizer will ensure that it is subject to constant surveillance by the security personnel. Only people badged with PASS "Sidi Wacho" provided by the producer or the organizer will be allowed backstage. The organizer is planning after-show passes for the band.

- Table for tour manager/production with power strip
- 16 x LR6 batteries such as Duracell +

To eat and drink:

- small buffet with bread, cheese and cold meats (separate plates), salads, fresh seasonal fruits (organic or regional specialties)...
- various 100% pure fruit juices, sodas, coffee, tea, milk, ...
- 24 beers of Belgian type preferably
- 6 non-alcoholic beers
- 2 bottles of good red wine (and a corkscrew)
- 1 jar of honey
- 1 bottle of good Artisanal Rum (brown) accompanied by limes, several bunches of fresh mint, cane syrup would be perfect!
- bottle opener, cups, spoons, knives, and everything you need for coffee / tea (filters, coffee maker, kettle, etc.)
- 7 small clean towels (5 for the stage, 2 for the dressing room)
- 12 small water bottles (for the stage)

MEALS

Hot meals (imperative) will be served for 8 people in the evening, before or after the show, depending on the concert times. Local and seasonal food is a great idea.

The organizer will provide a meal at noon if the schedules require the group to arrive before 2:00 p.m.

- 6 people have no special diet
- 2 people don't eat meat, you can provide fresh fish, omelet, tofu ...

If it is not possible to provide a meal, please provide a credit of 20 euros minimum per team member (to be given to the group representative on site).

ACCOMMODATION

Provide 8 singles with large beds and breakfasts in a minimum 2 star hotel, wifi, and secure parking for our vehicle. An additional hotel is likely to be negotiated depending on the routing (see with the tour manager). Please avoid cheap and uncomfortable hotels, and youth hostels.

RUN

- some members of the band may need runs from and / or to the station or the airport (see with the manager)
- if the accommodation is not on the site, please plan a run in the afternoon and/or after the concert to the hotel.
